

What is PEEP?

Peep groups are parent/carer and child groups that are about making the most of everyday life with babies and having fun. They build on what parents/carers already do and on babies' amazing ability to learn.



Peep groups run all over the country and have been shown to help children's very early learning and lead to success in later learning, particularly in reading and writing.

What can I get from PEEP?

Through joining in with Peep groups, parents/carers find out more about their babies' learning and growth and how they can support it. Parents/carers also have a chance to share their experiences and knowledge of their own children with other parents in a relaxed way. Parents/carers can make a record of their baby's successes and their own learning and are able to borrow 'play packs' so that they can share activities with their child at home.

Who is PEEP for?

The Baby Peep group will be for parents/carers that live within the Clevedon Children's Centre area and have a baby aged from birth to 12 months.
